1. Question regarding new products, COVID Effect and proposal for Stock split?

Stock Split: We cannot comment on the speculations and such decisions are taken by the Board of Directors and wherever necessary approval of shareholders is sought.

2. What is the impact on current employees and as well as employees who are not working from home?

At our plants locations i.e. Roha and Mahad, R & D Lab at Sutarwadi and at our Global Head Office in Pune, employees are working in terms of the guidelines being issued by the Government from time to time. We are also maintaining dialogue with Government Authorities at all locations.
